LOVE

"If I speak in the tongues of men or of angels, but do not have love, I am only a resounding gong or a clanging cymbal. If I have the gift of prophecy and can fathom all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have a faith that can move mountains, but do not have love, I am nothing. If I give all

I possess to the poor and give over my body to hardship that I may boast, but do not have love, I gain nothing."

-1 Corinthians 13:1-3

This is the month we celebrate Valentine's Day and we buy chocolates, flowers, diamonds, and many other things to show how much we love someone. Paul in the above verses talks about love in the Corinthian church. The church was composed of many types of people from a

variety of backgrounds with multitudes of gifts and abilities. It was easy for these differences to divide people. But despite the differences all believers have one thing in common that is faith.

Paul begins by saying, let me show you

the most excellent way...it is the way of love. In chapter 12, he speaks about spiritual gifts.

Paul says love is more important than spiritual gifts. Paul is saying that even if he were blessed that he could speak in

> many languages eloquently and does not have love, life is useless, it would sound like a gong or a clanging cymbal.

Secondly, Paul says that love is more important than knowledge, he says it is nothing. In 1 Corinthians 8:1, Paul said, "knowledge puffs up, but love builds up."

I don't think we need more knowledge as much as we need love for people to change, the society to change-we need people with a heart of love.

Thirdly, Paul states again love is more important than faith. He is not saying faith is not important but says love is more important. Verse 2, "If I have a faith that



can move mountains, but have not love, I'm nothing." Even faith is of no value unless it is backed up by love.

Finally we hear Paul saying love is more important than being generous, verse 3, "If I give all I possess to the poor and give over my body to hardship that I may boast, but do not have love, I gain nothing." Sometimes we give to impress others, we can get some benefit, or we can give to influence others; none of these are good enough reason if love is absent. The motive for giving should be love--love for God and love for God's people.

Paul in other words is saying love is more important than spiritual gifts, more important than knowledge, more important than faith and more important than generosity.

Jesus says in John 13:34, "A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another." Jesus is saying this is a commandment and not a suggestion.

Love begins in the family, spills into the church family and then into the world.

Paul explains what love is in verse 4-13, "Love is patient, love is kind. It does not

envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. It does not dishonor others, it is not selfseeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. Love never fails. But where there are prophecies, they will cease; where there are tongues, they will be stilled; where there is knowledge, it will pass away. For we know in part and we prophesy in part, but when completeness comes, what is in part disappears. When I was a child, I talked like a child, I thought like a child, I reasoned like a child. When I became a man, I put the ways of childhood behind me. For now we see only a reflection as in a mirror; then we shall see face to face. Now I know in part; then I shall know fully, even as I am fully known. And now these three remain: faith, hope and love. But the greatest of these is love."

As we celebrate love, let us remember what the Bible says about love.

God gave us love in spite of the pain and suffering of His own son, Jesus Christ. Let us emulate that same kind of love toward one another.






PrimeTime Trip Tuesday, February 9th 10:30 am Hong Kong Buffet in Marion


Church Office Closes for Presidents' Day Monday, February 15th
