### WORSHIP

*"I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful, I know that full well."* 

-Psalm 139-14

Worship is expressing our love to God for who He is, what He said, and what He is doing. When we speak of worship, we are talking about something only believers can do. We magnify God's name in worship by expressing our love and commitment to Him.

There are many appropriate ways to express our love to God, by praying singing, obeying, trusting, giving, listening, testifying and responding to His word. God, not man is the focus and center of worship.

Worship is acknowledging who God is, His holiness, Psalm 99:5, *"Exalt the Lord our God and worship at his footstool; he is holy,"* the Palmist states He is Holy.

God is loving in John 3:16. His love is willing to put His son on the cross for you and me because our sin separates us from Him.

In Isaiah 57:15-18, God is saying I want you back, I will heal you and guide you. As you read this passage we realize that His love for us is unbelievable. After all the things we have done, He is the only one who loves us regardless of our state. He wants us to come to Him with a contrite heart and lowly spirit so He can revive us.

Our worship should be reserved for God alone. Jesus says in Luke 4:8, *"It is written: 'Worship the Lord your God and serve him only."* 

God is worthy because of His position as king, honor and respect belongs to Him, the God of the universe. Our praise is based on His attributes. David says in Psalm 29:1-2, it is due Him. Jesus also states that if we don't praise God, even the "*stones will cry out*" (Luke 19:40).

God's presence must be sensed in the service. People are won to Christ by feeling God's presence. It is the sense of God's presence that melts hearts to serve Him. Our worship service starts the minute we step into the sanctuary, and we need to leave everything else outside. We have to come with the attitude that without His unmerited grace we are lost. Then it becomes a source of joy to our God. Worship is an attitude of the heart. A person can go through the outward motions but not be worshiping (Psalm 51:16-17, Matthew 5:5-3). God sees the heart, and He desires and deserves sincere, heartfelt praise and worship.
