"CALL ME" -GOD

"This is what the Lord says, he who made the earth, the Lord who formed it and established it—the Lord is his name: 'Call to me and I will answer you and tell you great and unsearchable things you do not know."

- Jeremiah 33:2-3 (NIV)

The passage helps us to ponder and reflect what God can do:

- 1. We are to call. (pray)
- 2. We are to expect an answer.
- 3. We are to know the unknown.

Most of us are not patient; we want our circumstances to go away or solved quickly rather than finding out what God wants to teach us or show us great things through the situation we are in. There is a purpose in the middle of our

trials. It forces us to have faith on what God is teaching us through HIS word (scripture). Sometimes God wants us to focus on recognizing who is the source of all things in our life. Our security should come from God, not on money, friends or family but GOD. This is very hard because our culture again and again stresses that if we don't do things for ourselves no one is going to do it for us, which is totally against what God wants from us, complete faith and trust in

<u>HIM</u>. When we do this, our focus is on God and not ourselves.

God wants us to come to Him first. He loves for us to come to Him because the word says He is the author of our lives, Jeremiah 33:2. He created the earth and established it. We need to remember as Charles Stanley says, "The shortest distance between our problems and their

solutions is the distance between our knees and the floor."

First we call (pray), secondly God answers. Verse 3, "Call to me and I will answer you and tell you great and unsearchable things you do not know.' God will not disappoint us. When HE says He will do something HE WILL KEEP HIS PROMISES.

It is not a question of will He answer? but what? we want to hear. Yes, that is our expectations when He doesn't answer the way we want. We think God has ignored our request but it is not true. His answers are, yes, wait, no--it is one of the three.

Just because we did not hear from God, we start to think, maybe we are not living right or guilty of things we have done, etc. God is sovereign. He has the right to do

according to HIS infinite wisdom, regardless of our goodness. His answers are always motivated by grace and love for us.

The third thing we learn from this verse is God will "show you great and mighty things (NIV). The Message Bible says, "wondrous things you could never figure out on your own."

We normally do not want to wait after we pray, we move on to do what we have already decided--God cannot--and will not--bless anything we do that is not of Him. Again our upbringing and culture dictates our behavior. John 15:16 says, "You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you so that you might go and bear fruit—fruit that will last—and so that whatever you ask in my name the Father will give you."

We are to seek His face because God wants to show Himself to us. We need to humble ourselves, and say "God you are good, we need you," with a submissive spirit. God is showing us in these verses that as we pray He will unveil insights that were previously a mystery to us. God wants to do much more than just meet our needs and answer our questions. He wants our lives and love for Him. He does not answer us according to our timetable, but always answers on time.

God is showing us to reach our community, meet our neighbors, help them to meet God and find His resources for their lives. We have an exciting journey before us. So, let us commit ourselves to pray and also through our actions invite others into the presence of God,
