This reminds me of the gift God gave us through His Son Jesus Christ. Jesus trusts me to take the gift and give it away to

the people who are desperate, needy, heart broken and to those who do not know there is a God who provides peace, joy, love and eternal life.

In the above story God used me as an instrument and extension of Him. The joy and pleasure was all mine.

LEADERSHIP COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS OF OCTOBER 2017 MEETING

Meeting called to order with prayer.

Additions to the Agenda: Reminder: Leadership Conference – Roger Palmer from Crossings is scheduled on Jan. 20th.

September Meeting Minutes: Minutes were approved by consensus with the following addendum: Direct Deposit payroll would not be cost effective (\$50 per month) so will continue issuing paper checks. Jesse discussed the possibility of relinquishing his position sometime in 2018.

September Financial Report approved. **Outreach and Evangelism:** It was suggested that the ministry teams meet to decide how to apportion their budget.

Missions: 2018 Mission Trip – Following the chicken & dumpling dinner the team will meet to decide on the destination. Young Estate Mission Funds--\$30,000 has been designated for missions. ABC Campus Ministry--we will check into what our funds are being used for. Shaker and Jesse met with Inter Varsity regarding Rachel's fundraising efforts. Kristy and Suzanne will meet with Rachel regarding financial support.

Children Discipleship: Looking into events at grade schools for Outreach. We want to do the 3-on-3 Basketball tournament again and would like to have more adults to mingle with the adults that attend. Will look into contacting the kids and parents to find out what they like about the after school program. Trunk R Treat at church is October 29th.

Youth Discipleship: There are several youth small groups for all ages at this time.

Adult Discipleship: SS Record Keeping will have a binder in each class, Laura Sims will get the numbers each month.

Have a sponsor for \$6500 so our cost will be \$1500-2000. Approved and taken from the Building Fund. Drums — current set is borrowed, cost to replace is approx. \$700. Ordering new hinges for the fence, have been hit and broken when the lawn was mowed.

Special Events: Update on the ABC GRR Region conference 9/29. Church picnic 10/1 – well attended – fun family event – thanks to those who coordinated. Great job! Christmas Banquet will be December 3rd. ABC GRR Area 4 Meeting will be April 2018. 150th Anniversary Team will be 10/2019.
