#### HOW DOES YOUR GIVING REFLECT GOD'S GRACE? by Rick Warren

"Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver. And God is able to bless you abundantly, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work."

2 Corinthians 9:7-8 (NIV)

If you want to measure how much you understand grace and how much you're living by grace, look at your giving.

The Bible says, "Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver. And God is able to bless you abundantly, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work" (2 Corinthians 9:7-8 NIV).

Notice the "alls" — "all grace," "all things," "at all times," "having all that you need" those are the promises related to the person who becomes like Christ. What was Christ like? He was a giver. God loved the world so much that he gave. Until you learn to be generous with your time, money, resources, and opportunities, you're not going to be like Christ. Nothing is greater proof that you understand grace than being lovingly gracious

and generous to other people and to God.

If you're uptight or defensive when your pastor starts talking about giving, it means you don't understand grace. Look at the verse again. He says if you give cheerfully and liberally, God will take care of all your needs — all the time, in every way, however you need them.

Here's the question: Are you going to trust the God who gave his life for you? If you can trust him enough for salvation, can't you trust him in your finances?

The truth is, you really don't own anything. God just loans it to you for 70 or 80 years. It's all His in the first place. If my daughter comes to me, and I give her five bucks to buy me a present, where's the money really coming from in the first place?

God does that with us. He gives to us generously. Then he says, "Now show a little gratitude. Be generous in giving, including your tithe." Does he need the money? No. He wants you to become like him. He wants you to have a heart that says, "I can't wait to give in every area."

Romans 8:32 says, "Since God loved us enough to give us his own son, won't he love us enough to take care of every one

The meeting was called to order with prayer.

**Minutes:** The February, 2018, minutes were approved by consensus.

**Financial Report:** The February 2018, Financial Report was approved by consensus.

#### **Ministry Team Reports:**

Outreach and Evangelism: Easter Prayer Walk 3/24. Spring Picnic/Outdoor Worship Service 5/6 – rescheduled for October 14. Ministerial Alliance Spring Festival 5/18 – we will have a couple of games. 6-8 pm at old MCA building. Have asked for a donation for tickets. Graduation Sunday will be 5/6.

Missions: 2018 Mission Trip — Kristy is applying for a \$1500 grant. Community Garden - Ron McLaughlin will be doing again this summer. Mission Meeting Update — will be helping a church in Puerto Rico. Will be giving the year's worth of donation to the Food Pantry to take advantage of their matching program. Donated \$100 to the 2018 Senior Prom dinner. Donated \$300 to the church in Jamaica to help with VBS. Donated \$3000 to the Living the Dream missionaries to help with the purchase of a vehicle.

Children Discipleship: New Curriculum – ordered and have started using it, love it. Connecting with Parents – will be reaching out to parents, to encourage involvement. Palm Sunday 3/25. Easter Egg Hunt 4/1. VBS 6/10-14 – Shipwreck theme Kids Camp – 7/29-8/1

Adult Discipleship: Young Adult/Profes-

sional Class Update – are meeting. New Small/Life Groups. Saturday Men's Breakfast starting back up.

**Staff Relations/Policies**: Next staff meeting in April – meets Quarterly.

**Finance and Stewardship:** Possible Financial Class. Stewardship Plan/Discussion **Legacy Giving Team:** Conversation with Pastor and Planned Giving Seminar Brunch 4/28

Buildings and Grounds: New Key Entry System – CTS cost is approx. \$4000 and comes with 50 fobs. Water and air leaks around side door – fixed. Water coming through North side Wall – will re-caulk when a little dryer. Heat Sensor in Boiler Room – Approx. cost is \$1500-2000 for heat sensor, alarm pulls and panic button that is mobile. Approved by consensus, take out of Building Fund. Will look into server space, etc. for the security cameras to be on their own computer.

**Security:** Cameras – Have them, will get them installed and interfaced.

Emergency/Evacuation Plans/Map of Building. Church liability Insurance –Anyone with concealed carry should have their own insurance and will have them sign a MOU and ask for proof of insurance.

**Special Events:** Easter Brunch – several volunteered to help with clean up.

ABC Brotherhood Meeting 4/10 – 6-8 pm,
40-50 people. Will be speaking about Puerto Rico and how they are still struggling after the hurricane. Will be asking us to partner with a church for a certain number of years. Shaker would like to donate \$1000 from our emergency fund. Approved by consensus.

Please mark your calendars and plan to attend this wonderful service which will be filled with many blessings.


