GRACE

"For the grace of God has appeared that offers salvation to all people."

Titus 2:11

Lately God is showing me how grateful I need to be for all the blessings we receive. It is the grace of God. We often talk about the topic of grace but it seems so elusive to describe it.

Grace simply stated, is the unmerited favor of God. Our salvation is through

grace Ephesians 2:8-9 says, "For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—not by works, so that no one can boast." Faith does not only believe that God can save the world, it believes that God, based upon His promise in HIS word, applies that forgiveness to our lives.

Titus 2:11 says, "the grace of God that brings salvation..."

Grace of God is not something that is hidden or something that is obscure... that we need to search for and hope we might discover it. It has been revealed.

In 2 Timothy 1:9 it says, "He has saved us and called us to a holy life—not because of anything we have done but because of his own purpose and grace. This grace was given us in Christ Jesus before the beginning of time." God saved us, called us because of grace.

God's grace is extended to every one of us. We need to reach out to receive the gift. It can never be achieved--it can only be received. One does not earn it or qualify for it. IT IS A FREE GIFT.

Let us read some points of what grace is...

- + Grace acknowledges the full implication of sin and yet does not condemn.
- + Grace is never just enough, grace is always far more than enough.
 - + God's expressions of grace are innumerable, His requirements are minimal.
 - + From the very beginning God has responded to the sin of humanity with amazing grace.
 - + God chose to extend grace to a graceless world because of His love. "And the scripture

was fulfilled that says, "Abraham believed God, and it was credited to him as righteousness, "and he was called God's friend. You see that a person is considered righteous by what they do and not by faith alone." James 2:23-24

- + The right standing with God comes through faith in the promises of God.
- + The presence of grace means that sometimes we don't get the consequences we deserve
 - + Grace is not reserved for good

people--grace underscores the goodness of God.

- + God initiated a relationship with His people before He even told them what the rules were--Grace.
- + The law of God is an expression of his grace.
- + Discipline is often an expression of grace.
- + God's discipline is not a payback but to bring us back.
- + Receiving grace is often easier than giving grace.
- + Grace is inviting to the unrighteous and threatening to the self-righteous.
- + Grace fills the gaps created by our sin or others.

Grace allows us to honestly face our past without being controlled by it.

The topic of grace of God is inexhaustible. Let us continue to explore it and be blessed by it.

LEADERSHIP COUNCIL APRIL MINUTES

Meeting called to order with prayer. Last Meeting's Minutes: March 29, 2019 minutes were approved by consensus.

The March 2019 Financial was approved by consensus.

<u>Deacons Report:</u> There were 21 people who attended/participated in the March 21 communion service at The Voyage Senior Living center. Flowers were sent to two families in the church. Visits with shut-ins were shared and discussed.

Ministry Team Reports:

Outreach and Evangelism: We are not doing neighborhood walk to deliver invitations for Easter outreach but have decided to post the flyer on social media. Community Spring Festival April 26 from 5-7 pm. May 19 Church in the Park event.

Missions: Rachel Edgar is moving to another campus and we would like to support her ministry there.

Youth Discipleship: Recognition of Graduates on Sunday May 19. Jake has started leading Wednesday night youth group. Camp fundraiser yard sale will be April 26-27 (Kathie Grob).

<u>Children's Discipleship</u>: VBS is scheduled for the week of June 2-6

<u>Family Discipleship</u>: Men's breakfast will be May 11.

Staff Relations: Choir Director position vacancy will be discussed in the near future. The IT position/job description has been approved with minor edits. A staff meeting is scheduled for 5/13

<u>Finance and Stewardship</u>: We will be forming a Stewardship Team sometime in May. There will be a stewardship drive sometime in September. "Ways to Give" stewardship brochure has been ordered.

We received and deposited into savings an additional \$100,000 from the Young Estate since the March Financial Report. It was decided by consensus that \$90,000 should be transferred to the Legacy Fund and \$10.000 to the Missions Fund.

Building and Grounds: Men's bathroom and Fellowship Hall floors are done. Rental house needs some minor repairs (renters are moving out) - tuck-pointing and new carpets. Hope to have it ready to rent by July 1. Youth house is messy and needs a deep cleaning in kitchen and carpets throughout. A used copier has been purchased for \$1395.00. Bus replacement proposal: Vic Koenig referred us to a dealership in Breeze, Illinois. Fire Department lock box has been ordered. Steve Wilkerson completed pew repairs. Flagpole needs to be replaced. Bids are being sought for laying asphalt in the gravel parking area. Special Events: Pam Lipe is supervising the Easter Brunch. 150th Anniversary October 18-19, Jessica Grammer will be working with the team.

Worship and Ministry Team: We now have an on-line subscription to "Song Select," and have access to music, chord sheets, slides, etc. There will be a Baptism and Membership service sometime after Easter. Emergency Response Team; Please park between the lines in designated parking spaces in the gravel lot.

Nominating Team: We still need 2 more people to serve on the Leadership Council. Deacon Care Team still needs three more people.

<u>Tech Report</u>: Bradley Evans will take over May 1 as Tech Support.




