

WHY IS LISTENING SO HARD

"My dear brothers and sisters, take note of this: Everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry,"

James 1:19(N/V)

everyone be quick to

listen

speak.

slow to anger..

Most of you reading this know that I am a pastor. Many come to me to share and discuss many things; spiritual and otherwise. So I have to listen to be able to discern and impart God's wisdom.

Most of us know what it takes to be a good listener. A good listener does not interrupt. A

good listener does not wait to insert their opinion, when the person pauses. A good listener asks follow up questions with genuine interest, and by their facial expressions and body language, allow for enough time for the speaker to finish.

We struggle to listen at least in large part, because our hearts and minds are fully convinced that others are worth listening to. Let me put it this way, we are

God's children and we love the Lord, but the difference is He loves us and listens to us with whatever we bring before Him. So we need to understand, as an example of God's character-need to listen to another child of God--as He does. HE treasurers them as much as HE treasures us.

James in his usual way of being direct, shares two human temptations. The first one is, "slow to speak." On the surface this seems obvious. It is hard to listen when we are the one talking. To be quick to speak is ultimately selfish.

Sometimes we do not allow others to share

because we are not really wanting to listen to the details of their life. We inwardly say get to the point; we have other things to do. Sometimes we are silent on the outside, but inside we are distracted and shut our ears to the person in front of us. James says to pay attention when others are speaking.

Secondly, he says take your time to speak. Do not get angry and stop listening to what they are saying. Our struggle to prove our answers, undermines their value, concern or perspective. Listening is an art. This comes to us through

our Savior Jesus Christ and the Holy Spirit which indeed is in us.

Our God is the best listener, the one who created us. The only being in the world who has no need to listen to anyone, for He already knows all things. and it is His special delight to hear our confused and incoherent chatter. Because He wants our fellowship, He gave His life for us, so the

least we can do is be willing to listen to others. We all struggle with listening but God's word teaches us to be patient, loving, and kind. I do have my own struggles with listening and am working to get better.

Let me close with what Paul says in Philippians 2:1-4, "Therefore if you have any encouragement from being united with Christ, if any comfort from his love, if any common sharing in the Spirit, if any tenderness and compassion, then make my joy complete by being like-minded, having the same love, being one in spirit and of one mind. Do nothing out of selfish ambition



 Students will be helping with VBS, looking forward to Youth Camp in June and Mission Trip in July.

Kids: AWANA program, is off to a great start! 3 kids have given their lives to the LORD! Leaders are doing an amazing job. Church has gotten behind the program with their prayers, support, funds, assistance. More volunteers would be welcomed. VBS will be June 6-11. Kids Camp will be in July. Mission the Month



American Baptist missionaries Larry and Becky Stanton have been serving in Hungary for seven years. Becky was able to teach in-person this year, and through your generous giving, the Stantons were able to provide meals for the teachers and staff who were hit by COVID, a ministry the school headmistress dubbed "COVID Catering." The virus struck Hungary with its third wave this March, closing the schools and prompting International Ministries to call their Hungarian missionaries home for the spring and summer.

Unfortunately because of COVID restrictions, Larry wasn't able to visit the communities where he normally provides firewood, basic necessities, and refugee relief, but he was able to join Hungarian Baptist Aid on two disaster relief trips to Croatia where an earthquake left 30,000 people homeless in December of 2020.

The Stantons are excited to visit FBC and grateful for your partnership in ministry! Please pray they can return to Hungary in August and that their relationships with the people they've been discipline are made stronger than ever.


