THE APOSTLES CREED


THE APOSTLES CREED

I believe in God the Father Almiahtv, Maker of heaven and earth. And in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord; Who was conceived by the Holy Spirit; Born of the Virgin Mary; Suffered under Pontius Pilate: Was crucified, dead and huried; He descended into Hell: The third day He rose again from the dead; He ascended into heaven: And sitteth on the right hand of God the Father Almighty; From thence He shall come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holv Spirit; The Holy Christian Church, the Communion of Saints; The Forgiveness of sins; The Resurrection of the body; And the life everlasting, Amen.

"Jesus heard that they had thrown him out, and when he found him, he said, "Do you believe in the Son of Man?" Then the man said, "Lord, I believe," and he worshiped him." John 9:35 & 38 (NIV) Jesus asked the blind man, "Do you believe

in the Son of God?" His reply was simple, "I believe." It showed the faith of the man after Jesus' explanation. He specifically said, "Yes, I believe." Here you see it is a relationship, and he worshiped Him.

Today many Christians do not know what the Apostles Creed is, if they do, they think it is archaic --not applicable to today's faith. In the early Christian church the Apostle's Creed condensed the faith of God's word to people in a simple way. A creed is simply a statement of belief.

In the early days it was designed to be used as a way for Christians to express their common understanding of their faith. As you read through it you can see it is a summary of Biblical truth.

The Apostle's Creed was not written by the apostles. The early Christians took the words of Jesus from Matthew 28:19, *"Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit," (NIV) as the foundation to share the good news to the world.*

The early teachers wrote short creeds, based on scripture, to help new converts understand Christianity.

The first part of the creed is an affirmation of our belief in God as our Father, the almighty and creator. It shows that God is absolutely sovereign overall.

Secondly, it affirms that Jesus is the only Son of God. He is our Lord and Savior by virtue of His deity, conception (virgin birth). life, passion, death and resurrection.

Thirdly, it is about the Holy Spirit and the work of the Holy Spirit on earth in the church.

The creed does not address the word of God, upon which our faith is grounded. It does not say anything about sin, the knowledge of which is absolutely necessary for salvation.

It also does not address justification by faith alone, that is how we receive right standing with God. The creed also does not address worship, serving God and leading a holy life. In Hebrews 12:14, *"Make every effort to live in peace with everyone and* *to be holy; without holiness no one will see the Lord," (NIV)* we read that without holiness no one will see the Lord. But all of this is alluded to in the creed, either explicitly or implicitly.

The point is the facts of the statements made in the creed are important in terms of giving us true information. It summarizes major truths.

It helps us express that we believe in the truth about God, and we are living in a relationship of commitment to God, and trust Him. We show faith in God by bowing to His claim to rule and manage our lives by receiving Jesus Christ as our Lord and Savior. Our faith depends on hearing, receiving, noting, and doing what God says. Each individual must affirm their own faith. You cannot affirm someone else's faith.

It does no good to recite the Apostle's Creed if you do not understand it. The Apostle's Creed will help you understand and clarify what you believe about God the Father. God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit.

I believe every once in a while it would be good to renew our faith and acknowledge who is the Lord of our life. The fall is here with the gentler breeze, beautiful changing colors of the trees, and sunsets to enjoy. Have a wonderful season.

Children's Hope International is an organization with people that have a burning passion for changing the lives of the helpless, vulnerable, the orphans, the sick, the weak, and the poorest of children and families.

Their Hope is in God and their intent is taking God's love to those whose candle has gone out and hope has died. Children's Hope is committed, as partners in Hope, to share what God has given them, to those in need.

Children's Hope reaches out to all people of compassion to join them in making a world of difference. Their work began 37 years ago and focuses on China (where it began), India, Cambodia, and Ethiopia.

Children's Hope International focuses on children who are orphans, abandoned, and forgotten. These children are often sick or with special needs. As of now, over 8,000 orphans have been placed in homes and many more were given medical help and spiritual hope. Children's Hope started a home for special needs orphans, as was a center for abused girls. 50 Little Homes were started as residence centers near hospitals for families and children in medical crisis for them to live, be given encouragement and prayer in their time of need.




