BE THANKFUL

"Rejoice always, pray continually, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus." I Thessalonians 5:16-18

In the above scripture we hear Paul sharing about a very important message for the Thessalonians church.

society of ingratitude that is all around us. When we are not willing to live a grateful life before others it is indicative that we are not grateful before God.

Ingratitude exists in our life because we are not in prayer and worship constantly. God wants us to be thankful, so our life can overflow with His abundant life.

Sometimes we feel entitled to happiness and prosperity because we are Christians. God does not owe us. We owe Him everything. He has already given us everything we need now and in the future. Through His son and his death on the cross for us. We have been blessed far beyond what we can hope for or imagine.

We must return to having hearts that are overflowing with thankfulness. People often take life for granted rather than considering it a gift.

This Thanksgiving Season we need to look back at the past year to see how God has blessed us in every way. Yes, some of us have lost loved ones, but they have left us with memories and their lives are an example for us to follow. We need to be thankful we have a roof over our head, food on the table, and a church family that
