"I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. Now there is in store for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will award to me on that day—and not only to me, but also to all who have longed for his appearing." 2 Timothy 4:7-8

It has been said that becoming a Christians is relatively easy. Some have even perceived it as being too easy. But a real and abiding faith requires much more. Our genuine faith requires perseverance. . to cross the finish line. We don't auit.

Paul says, "I have fought a good fight, and I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. 2 Chronicles 15:7, "But as for you, be strong and do not give up, for your work will be rewarded," says there is a reward.

My passing encouragement to all of you is:
-Don't give up when you feel the soul
weariness for long battles with persistent
weakness. 2 Corinthians 12:9, "But he said
to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my
power is made perfect in weakness." Therefore
I will boast all the more gladly about my
weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest
on me."

-Don't give up when your long asked, sought and knocked prayers have not been answered. -Don't give up when the devil's fiery darts of doubt make you reel.
