Took 50 students and leaders, had 13 students stand and give their lives to Jesus! 8 students are registered for the summer Mission trip. Small Group leaders have been invited to the Small Group Leaders Meeting in July. Small Groups will resume beginning in August, Youth Group will start back the middle of September. Laser Tag Lock-In is being planned. HS Girls retreat will be September 2-6, KIDS: VBS Kick-Off was great with food, drinks, snow cones and the Fire Truck. VBS week was awesome! 6 kids gave their lives to Jesus! TREK Kids Club program and Small Group on Sunday mornings are going great! The Youth house has had the deck stained and Gutter guards installed. The trailer has had the jack fixed and new tires. The bus and van have been cleaned and the van has the oil changed. Painted the south and west exterior areas. Future Projects: Bus and Van need IDOT # and logo signage. Ordered Sanctuary lights, new lights for outside entries. Painting exterior areas on the North and East sides. Landscaping needed to hide all units in front of church. Resealing parking lot, North side Education wing gutter. Outside door signs and Walnut Street signs. Rental House needed repairs.


COMMUNION AT VOYAGE ASSISTED LIVING
