A TRUE LEGACY GIFT



Another surprise moment occurred recently at FBC in which an unexpected legacy gift was received from the Estate of Jim "JD" Carlock. Mr. Carlock was a long-time member of our church, serving as Head Usher for many years, and otherwise being present on Sundays and other times along with his mother while she was living and many years following her death.

Jim died in April 2021, but he had thoughtfully included FBC in his Last Will and Testament leaving a gift amounting to \$40,000+ to our church.

These generous acts are so far reaching to our church – it indicates that as a member, the church and its members and ministries touched a life very deeply. This legacy gift will be used in the continued ministry at FBC for some time to come.

This gift will also be used as a reminder that we all have the ability to make a designation in several different ways in order to set up a gift upon our death. There are ways to do this that only require a small amount of effort on your part. You could do something as simple as adding a Codicil (additional language) to your Will designating a gift in a specific amount or a percentage of your estate upon your death. A form for this purpose is available in the church office for your review and use. Another method would be to set up your checking or savings account with a POD (payable on death) in a specific amount to the church as a legacy gift.

Let's remember Mr. Carlock and others who have left legacy gifts to our church, and how their generosity has benefited FBC. What a wonderful way to bless the church where you have worshiped for a part or most of your life, and perpetuate the ministries established or that may be started in the future.
